

Activities of the Association Roads & Transport

- The 7.5tonne restriction is now in force on Oakley Green Road and Fifeld Lane although it is currently being ignored by the hauliers. Two lorry watches have taken place but more needs to be done to ensure that this restriction is adhered to.
- The promised reduction in speed limit on OGR is yet to be introduced. We are trying to chase this.
- The Fifield Crossroads roundabout is still on our wish list
- Still trying to extend/improve Footways on Fifield Road and Oakley Green Road.
