



We are still conversing with the Royal Borough with regard to our three proposals for improving the current bridleway network.

The suggested upgrade of footpath 59 between Drift road and Oakley Green Road is not looking promising due to the concerns of one of the land-owners.

The upgrade of footpath 52 however, is looking far more feasible. Following constructive talks with the Borough and subsequent discussions with the two land-owners involved it seems there may be a way to move forward with this project. Talks are still in the early stages but so far everyone is being open-minded and we are optimistic that a positive outcome may be achieved.

Regarding the access to the Great Park via the Legoland bridleway we have not had any update from the Borough. At our last meeting they were in the process of renewing their request with the Crown Estate but so far we have not heard news of their response.

All of these proposals need to be discussed with all interested parties; land-owners, the Royal Borough, Parish Council, Rambler's association and Crown Estate in particular. If successful considerable funding will be needed to provide suitable surfaces for all-weather usage. RBWM are anxious that before any money is spent they have assurance that community members will use these bridleways on a regular basis. So, if you are a cyclist or a horse-rider and would use any of these proposed routes please let us know via the usual channels.

If anyone has any other suggestions for improving the network please let us know and we will obviously keep you informed of any progress with the current proposals.
