RE: DRAINAGE SCHEME: CONINGSBY LANE, FIFIELD (UPDATE 2019)

Engineering works to implement a new drainage scheme are to commence next week. The works are expected to last 6-8 weeks.

There will be some carriageway incursion, but access to Coningsby Lane will be maintained. It is intended that the footpath next to 'The Mulberrys' will remain open for use during the works, with the team on site happy to assist anybody who wishes to use it, although it is possible that access through the footpath could be delayed at times due to logistical and health and safety reasons.

These works are an essential part of the Council's ongoing maintenance and improvement programme and are designed to alleviate the occasional ponding problem near the junction of Coningsby Lane and Fifield Road. Your patience and co-operation would be appreciated to ensure the contractor is able to complete the works as quickly as possible and with minimum inconvenience. In particular, please do not park on the highway within the vicinity of the scheme during the works.
