What is this all about?

RBWM are consulting on the Borough Local Plan which forms the vision of how Windsor and Maidenhead will look in the future and what may be built where. Once approved, this Plan will be used to assess all future planning applications.

How does this affect Bray Parish?

14,240 additional dwellings need to be found by the end of the planning period in 2033. The sites for 7,400 household spaces have already been identified leaving 6,840 spaces to be found across the Royal Borough. The edge of settlement documents in January 2014 and July 2016 identified a number of potential sites across the Royal Borough. The Borough Local Plan Site Allocation Proforma show the proposed development envelopes in the Green Belt. For the Parish of Bray these are;

HA7: Land South of Harvest Hill Road and Kimbers Lane, Maidenhead

HA9: Land South of the A308(M), west of Ascot Road and North of the M4 (known as the Triangle Site)

HA11: Land west of Windsor, north and south of the A308, Windsor

HA17: Tectonic Place, Holyport Road, Maidenhead

HA18: Land between Windsor Road and Bray Lake, south of Maidenhead

HA23: Land west of Monkey Island Lane, including water treatment works, Maidenhead
